Landfill Monitoring. The Town has completed 28 years of the 30 year monitoring per NYSDEC. Ken Aplin who has been completing annual monitoring has announced his retirement. He recommended On Site Geological Services, a company out of Wellsville, NY. They have been doing landfill monitoring for some time and are qualified to perform this service.
